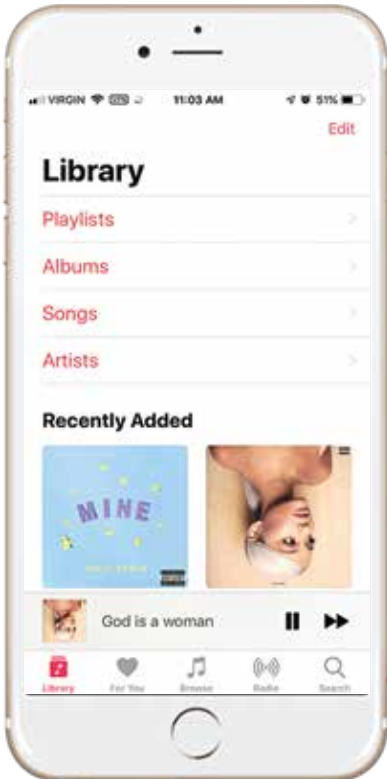




# Main Components

# Library

Library is where your enjoyment starts. Here, you will find all the singles, albums, playlists that you have **added**. It is divided in multiple sections to find what songs you want to play. Every section is created for you to find your items easily. If you swipe down, you will find your recently added songs. Right underneath, you have the music player. Click on it and it will lead you to the "Now Playing" menu. (See instructions for the "Now Playing" menu on page 23.) At the bottom of the screen you have the navigation between the different main components of the app.



# For You

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The “For You” section is for you to discover or maybe rediscover artists and music based on your current library. Apple Music’s algorithm chooses songs and playlists for you to listen to.

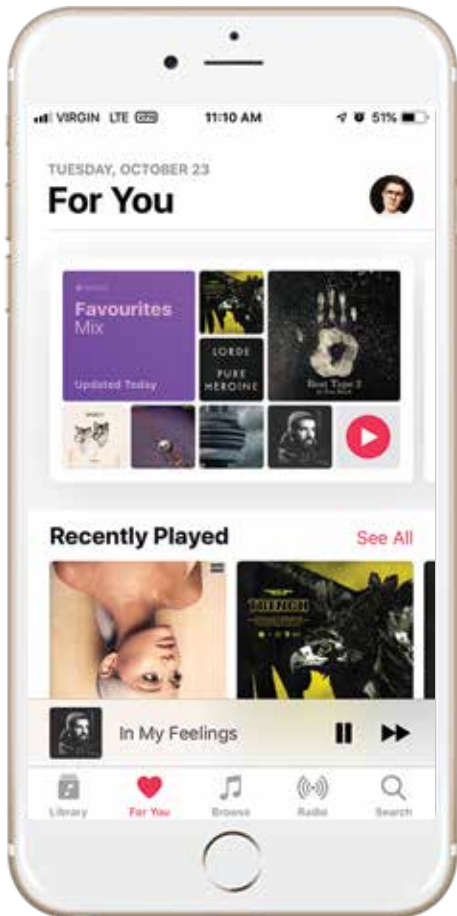
## Playlist Made for You

Every Week, Apple creates playlist such as “Favourites Mix”, a playlist with the music you listen the most, “Chill Mix”, a playlist with a chill vibe for you to listen to while studying or doing something else, and “New Music Mix”, a playlist where Apple finds music you would enjoy.

## Daily Playlists

Daily Playlists are Apple Music’s public playlists that we recommend for you to listen based on your library choices. They change every single day so make sure you either save the playlists you enjoy or remember their names so you can look it up in the search component.





## Connect Posts

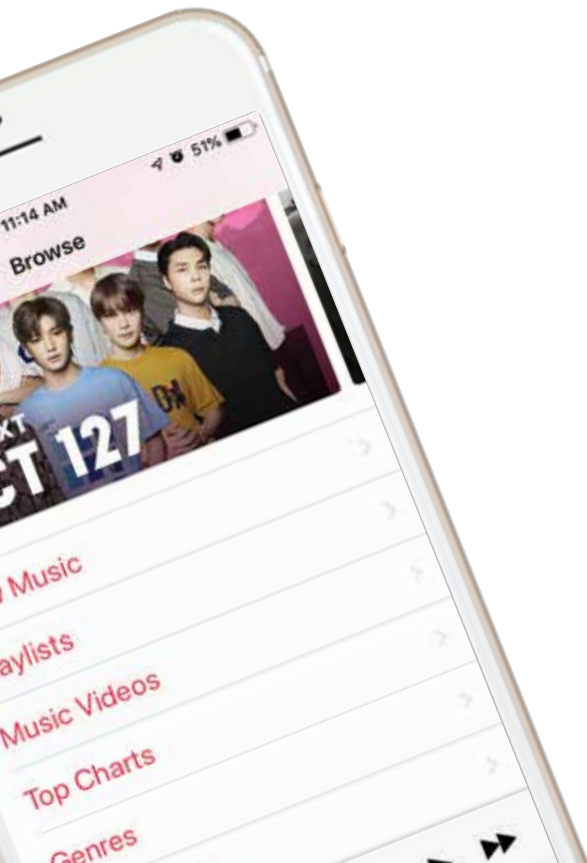
See what your favorite artists have to say, here on connect posts. Announcements and surprises are posted regularly so don't miss them! You will find this section at the end of the "For You" page if you swipe down.

## Heavy Rotation

Based on Apple's algorithm, Heavy Rotation recommend you to listen to all your favorite albums you have been recently listening to just so you don't waste your time looking for them in your library section.

# Browse

Browse in our **Apple Music Library** to find some new music to add to yours. From Top Charts music to specific genre music, there will always be something hiding for you to enjoy. You can also search for multiple music videos from your favorite artists.



# Radio

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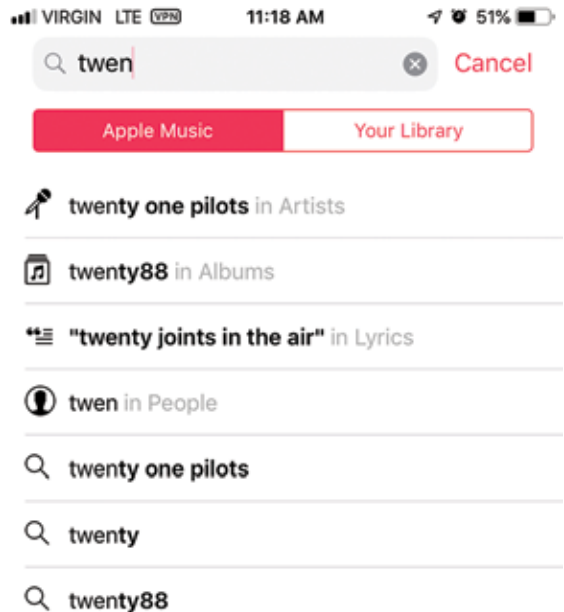
Choose from a variety of radio shows hosted by enthusiastic lovers of music depending on what you want to listen to. You can also find interesting interview from multiple artists.

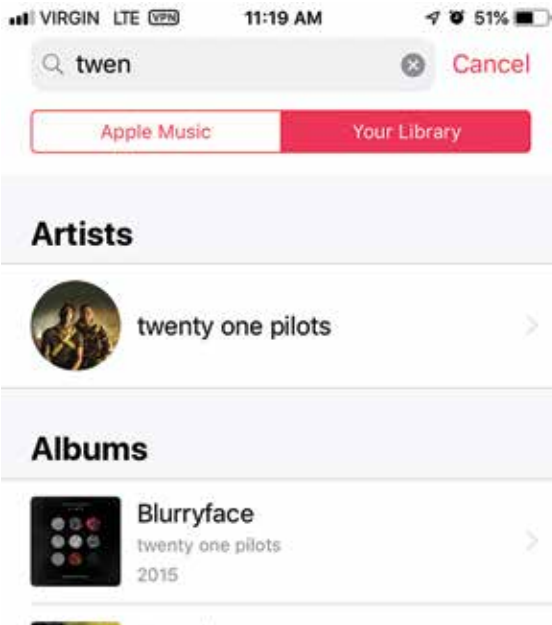


# Search

## Search in Apple Music

By clicking on the Apple Music bar, you have the opportunity to search through all Apple Music's data including songs, albums, artists, music videos that you haven't added to you library.





## Search in Your Library

By clicking on the “Your Library”, you can search through your added music instead of looking through your entire library. You can search through albums, songs, artists and music video that are inside your library only.

# Adding Music

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Now that you know how to navigate through the app, the other important step to be comfortable with Apple Music, is to learn how to add music to your library. Whether you are in the "For You", "Browse" or "Search" section, you can click on these symbols and it will directly add the songs or albums to your library.



# iCloud Music Library

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Apple Music is an iCloud based service, meaning that you can connect to your iCloud on any device and you will have all the music you added to your library. Since everything is set in the cloud, it needs Wi-Fi or data to be accessed. Therefore, Apple Music offers you the option to download your music on the device you are using so you can listen to your favorite songs without Wi-Fi or data.



Click on this symbol to download the songs or albums you want. The symbol is an illustration of you releasing the song/album out of the cloud. It will still be in your iCloud Music Library.

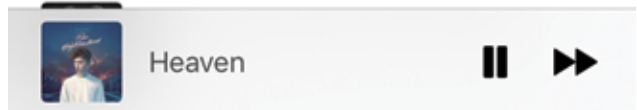

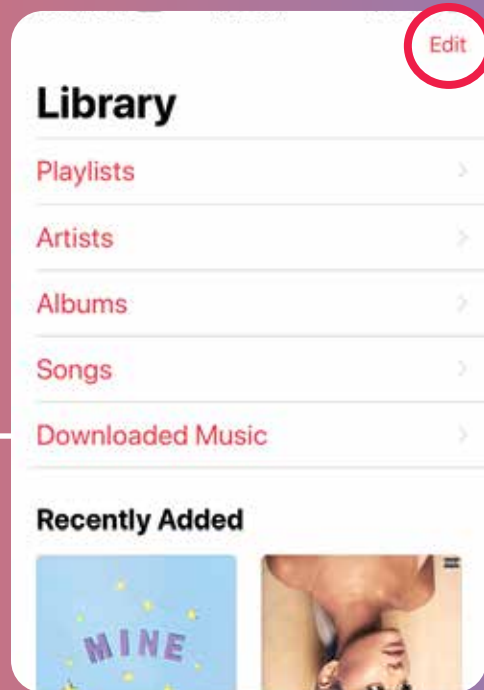

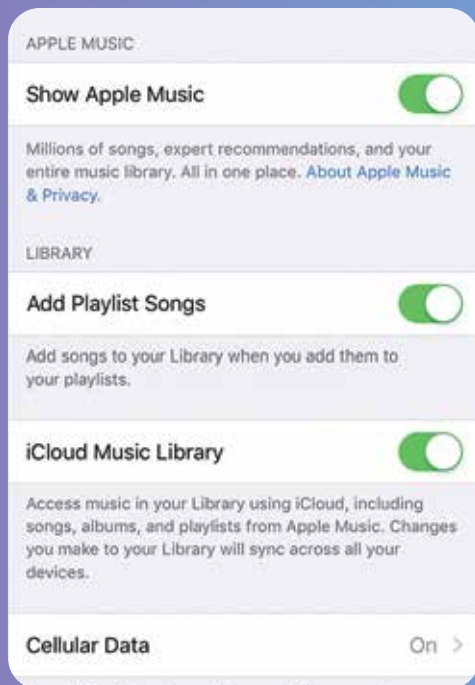
You can add the “Downloaded Music” panel to only listen to your downloaded music by clicking edit on the top right of your device.

You can access your iCloud Library settings in the settings app in the “Music” section.

You can decide to remove cellular data to listen to music without being scared of using your data too much.



# Create and Save Playlists


Playlists are a fun and exciting way to play your music. It lets you create a mix of song that you like and that fits well together. Here is how you can take advantage of this feature.



## Create Playlists

In the "Playlists" section of the "Library" component, click "New Playlist...". It will lead you to this page showed on this iPhone X™. You can add a photo from your Photo Library, create a title and a description for your playlist. The next step is to add your Music. You can only select music from your library. If you want add any other songs outside of your library, you will need to use the 3D Touch feature (See instructions for the "3D Touch Menu" on page 26).

## Save Playlists

Saving a playlist is as easy as adding an album. To save a playlist you simply look through the “Browse” component. When you find a playlist you enjoy, click on the  button.



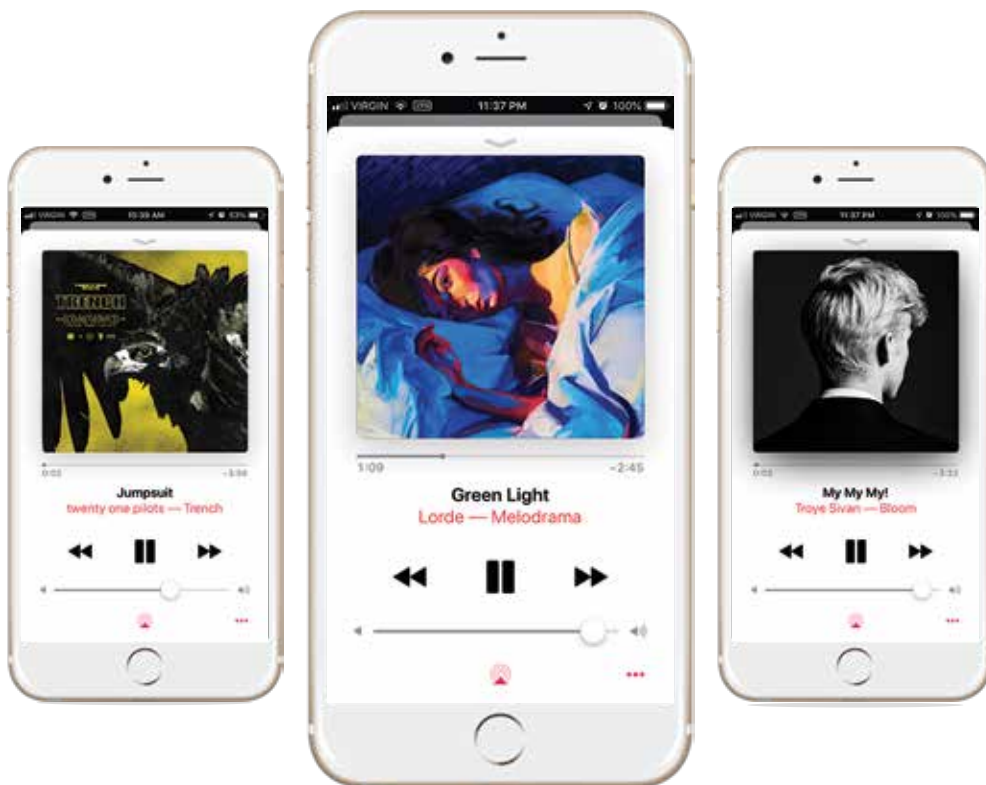

# Now Playing Menu

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## Main Menu

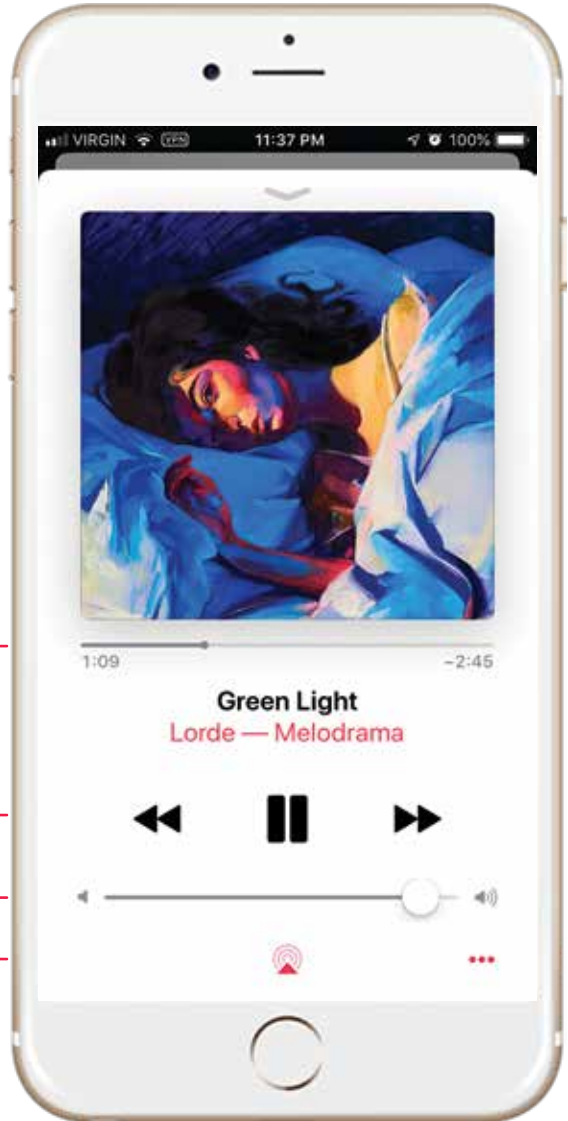
As seen on page 7, you can click on the bar with the name of the song playing and this menu will pop out. This menu lets you know what is playing by displaying the album cover, The name of the artist, album and song. . You can swipe the little circle to go backwards or go forwards. The "... " buttons will show up the 3D Touch Menu (See instructions for the "3D Touch Menu" on page 26).

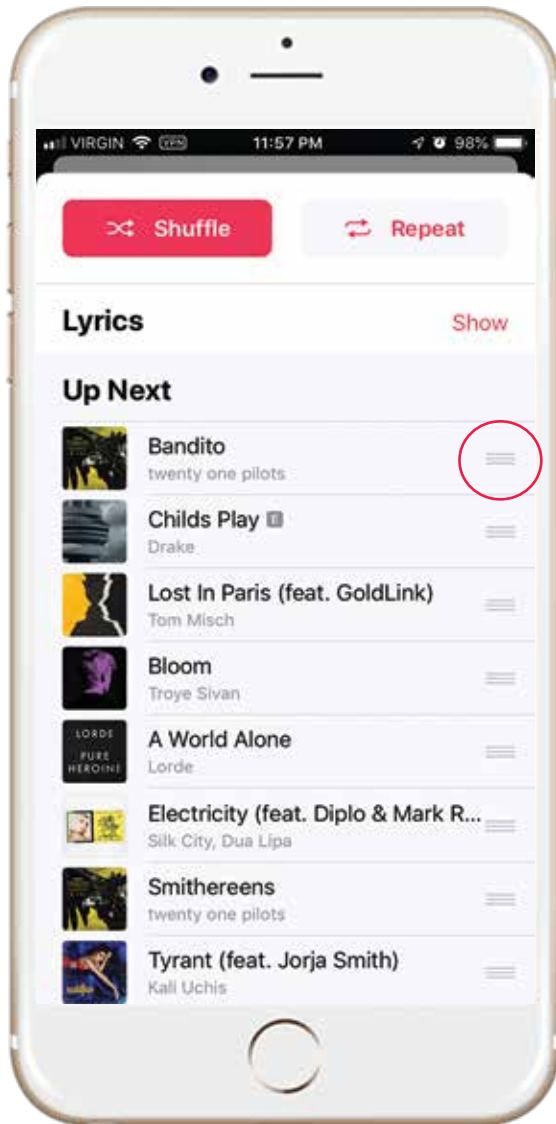

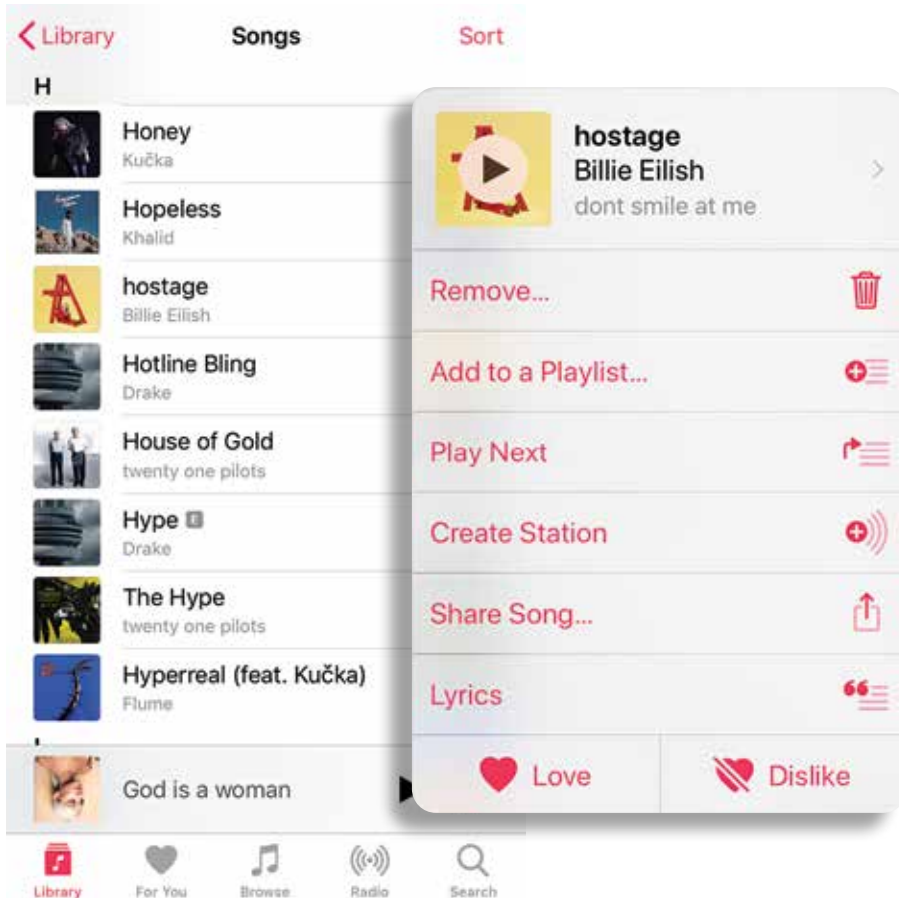

## Slide Down Menu

If you slide your finger upwards on the “Main Menu”, this menu will show up. You can decide to play your music on shuffle, in which Apple will play your songs randomly, and repeat the song once played. You also have the option to see the lyrics for certain songs. Simply click on the “Show” button. Underneath, you have the songs that will be played next.

# 3D Touch Menu




To activate this menu, simply hold the song/album/artist you want to select and press slightly on the screen. This function is only available for iPhone 6s™ and newer versions. If you have an older version. Simply hold the item for 3 seconds and the menu will show up. It lets you add the item to a playlist, play the item next, create station, which is a specialized playlist that will play right when you click on it, and other options.

# Glossary

**Air Play:** designed to take a user's iTunes multimedia content from the device on which it's hosted and make it available to multiple other sources, including supported speakers/stereo systems, an AirPort Express or an HDTV set.

**Apple Music Library:** Apple Music data. There are over 40 million songs available on this streaming service.

**iCloud:** computing solution that provides the ability to store documents, videos, photos, music and other data online and the ability to sync it between iOS-powered devices.

**Library:** where all your music that you have added is located.

**Song:** I hope you know what that is.

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
