The Sunflower:

The sunflower (*Helianthus annuus*) is a living annual plant in the family Asteraceae, with a large flower head (capitulum). The stem of the flower can grow up to 3 metres tall, with a flower head that can be 30 cm wide. To grow well, sunflowers need full sun.

Colors: Yellow, browns, and mixed

Height: 3-16 feet

- Blooms during Sumer
- Most varieties are drought and heat tolerant
- Attracts bees, birds, and butter flies
- Tolerates most soil types (Except water-logged)

The Coneflower:

General Description: Purple coneflower is a relatively large wildflower, ranging from 30–150 cm. in height. As indicated by its name, the flower head has a prominent, spiny, brown central cone that is surrounded by light purple or white petal-like rays.

Colors: Yellow, orange, white, purple, pink, bicolor and more

- Sow seeds in spring or fall

The Zinnia:

Zinnias are popular garden flowers because they come in a wide range of flower colors and shapes, and they can withstand hot summer temperatures, and are easy to grow from seeds. They are grown in fertile, humus-rich, and well-drained soil, in an area with full sun.

Colors: Variety

Height: 5-24 inches

- Bloom non-stop from June until frost
- Attract birds
- Are great for growing along the edges of a path
- Prefer loamy soil
- Keep them moist, but not water logged

Cosmos, like many of our warm weather annuals such as marigolds, originated in Mexico and South America. Cosmos belongs to that vast family of plants known as Compositae. Although there are 20 known species of cosmos, two annual species.

- Helps repel mosquitoes

The Morning Glories:

Morning glories are annual climbers with slender stems, heart-shaped leaves, and trumpet-shaped flowers of pink, purple-blue, magenta, or white. They have beautifully-shaped blooms that unfurl in the sun and romantic tendrils that lend old-fashioned charm.
