Here you'll learn how to get tarted with your VSCO profile


With the application open, tap on the  $\bigcirc$  to get started (fig. A1)

Choose a username and enter a meaningful password. Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions.


Tap on the  $\rightarrow$  to complete setting up your VSCO profile (fig. A3)

## Importing — Your Images

With VSCO, you can import your own previously taken images from your phone's camera roll. Here, you'll learn how to select and import images to your VSCO Studio, where you can edit them now, or later.

With the application open, tap on the  $\oplus$  in the lower quadrant to get started. This will give you access to your Studio, where all your pictures will be.

In your VSCO studio, press on the + to begin to view your device's gallery (fig. 3A).



Note when you select a photo, a gold border will appear to leave you know you have selected that photo



